Update for International Student and Scholar Advisors

As reported in NAFSA.news on September 23, NAFSA's Board of Directors approved the formation of two new committees to replace the Policy and Practice Committee (P&P), including the new Education Abroad Regulatory Practice Committee (EA-RP) and the International Student and Scholar Regulatory Practice Committee (ISS-RP). The EA-RP will focus on government-related issues for education abroad students and programs, including financial aid, U.S. travel regulations and documents, and foreign visas. The ISS-RP will focus on immigration-related issues that impact students and scholars.
